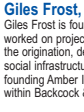
Charles Dumas, Chief Economist LOMBARD STREET RESEARCH

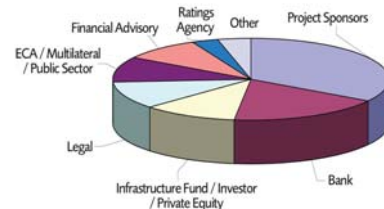
